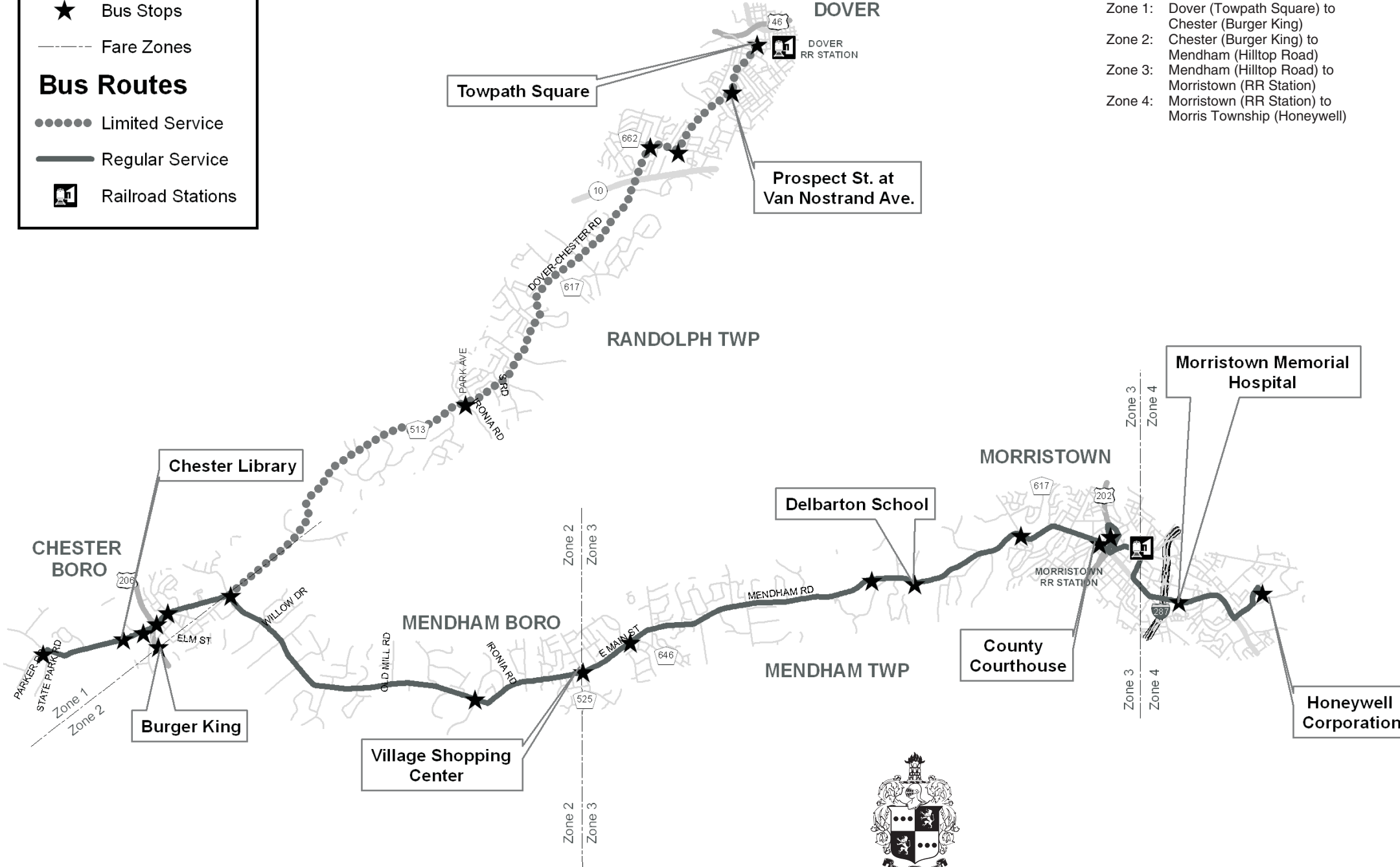

## WHERE TO GET THE BUS

Buses only stop at locations where there are bus stop signs. These signs are conveniently located where it is safe for buses to stop. Where there are great distances between bus stop signs, please telephone PABCO Transit at (973) 328-7686 to schedule a safe and convenient stop.

## FLEXIBLE ROUTING

MCM 4, 5, and 7 buses may travel off the regular routes to serve customers. Call PABCO Transit at (973) 328-7686 by 11 AM the day before the bus comes to your town, to schedule a flexible routing trip.

## HOLIDAY SERVICE

Buses DO NOT operate on the following holidays: New Year's Day\*, Memorial Day, Independence Day\*, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day\*. A Saturday schedule (if service operates on Saturdays) is in effect on President's Day.

\*When this holiday occurs on a Sunday it is observed on Monday and no service is operated.

## How to use this schedule

1. Choose the direction you wish to travel and locate the WEEKDAY, SATURDAY or SUNDAY schedule. Timepoints are listed from the beginning of the route (on the left) to the end (on the right).
2. Timepoints in the schedule correspond with the timepoint dots on the map. If your stop is between two timepoints, use the earlier time as a guide.
3. If there is a letter to the left of the times listed for the trip you wish to take, look for the explanation under or next to the schedule block.
4. Check departure location information on front, if applicable. Be sure to see other special notes for more information.
5. Be sure to check the bus destination sign before boarding the bus.

*Information in this timetable is subject to change without notice. Traffic conditions, construction, and weather can affect trip time.*

## MAPS - TRANSPORTATION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS AND DISABLED RESIDENTS

The Morris Area Paratransit System (MAPS), a Morris County government service, provides curb-to-curb transportation for Morris County residents who are age 60 and over, or disabled adults. Most MAPS vehicles are equipped with wheelchair lifts. For further information, call MAPS at (973) 366-9378.

## TRANSFERS

When taking a trip using two different MCM or NJ TRANSIT (NJT) bus routes, the total fare will be cheaper if you purchase a transfer from the first bus driver. Transfer locations to other bus lines and trains are listed below:

**Dover – Towpath Square at Blackwell St./Prospect St. (close to RR Station):**

MCM 2, 5, 7, 10;  
NJT Rail Morristown Line,  
NJT Rail Montclair-Boonton Line

**Randolph - Reservoir Rd. at Quaker Church Rd.:**  
MCM 2

**Randolph - Quaker Church Rd. at Dover –Chester Rd.:** MCM 2

**Chester - North Road at Rt. 24:** MCM 5

## Fare Information

This is an exact fare line. Passengers are required to have exact fare when boarding buses on this line. One dollar bills and most U.S. coins are accepted. Drivers do not carry money and cannot make change.

## How to determine your fare

Your fare is based on the number of zones you travel through. Check the map on this schedule to see how many zones you travel. Each time you cross a zone boundary, you must pay for another zone.

## Reduced Fare Program

**Children's Fares** - Ages 5-11 save 50% or more from regular one-way fares at all times. Up to three children ages four and under ride free with a passenger paying any fare.

**Senior Citizens 62 and older and passengers with disabilities** can travel on-board NJ TRANSIT trains, buses, and light rail vehicles at a reduced fare of one-half the regular one-way fare or less at all times. **Seniors Citizens 62 and older** may be asked to present a valid ID (any ID or document printed with your date of birth and issued by a government, social service, or mass transportation agency) to obtain the reduced fare. Valid ID for Seniors 65 and older also includes the MTA Reduced Fare Card; PA Senior Citizen Transit ID or PACE Card; PATH Senior Fare Card; or Medicare Card. **Passengers with disabilities** must present an NJ TRANSIT Reduced Fare ID or Medicare Card to obtain the reduced fare. **Monthly Passes** are available for frequent riders at a substantial discount from the regular fare. Buy a pass at a NJ TRANSIT ticket agent or through NJ TRANSIT Mail-Fare, One Penn Plaza East, Newark, NJ 07105-2246. Call 1(800) 648-0215 for more information.

## You Can Ride With Your Rail Pass

Passengers with NJ TRANSIT rail monthly or weekly passes printed with a bus-zone number may use their passes on NJ TRANSIT buses up to the number of imprinted bus-zones during the period that the pass is valid.
